ETSA Contax: Angove to finish what she began

ETSA Contax Netball Club moved quickly to shore up its coaching ranks following the appointment yesterday of its Club Coach, Tania Obst, to the full time position as Netball Coach at the South Australian Sports Institute (SASI).

Club President, Lee-Anne Petherick announced today that retiring SASI coach Margaret Angove will return to the club as head coach for 2010.

"Losing Tania as 2010 coach in the last week before the commencement of matches isn't what we had in mind, as our whole squad has been working hard for some time now to reclaim the premier position in State League Netball in South Australia," Lee-Anne said.

"We considered promoting our wonderful State League Reserves Coach Leanne Eichler to the senior role, but she feels she is not quite ready. She is a young mum with family commitments and is not yet fully qualified to coach at State League level. We thought what better way to support Leanne, than to give her a coaching mentor as well as one who can help train her to attain her level two qualifications."

Margaret Angove steps down from the SASI role and moves straight back into the role she held at ETSA Contax up to the 1996 season when she moved to be the inaugural coach of the Thunderbirds.

Angove has coached Contax previously to five State League championships and one Super League title. She was also at the helm of the Thunderbirds when they won their two national league crowns.

"There is no more highly credentialed coach in South Australia and we are delighted that she has agreed to help us as a club this year, and more importantly to help our players to achieve the success they so desperately want in season 2010," Lee-Anne said.
