## Planned interruptions to electricity supply

Electricity supply to around 800 customers on Kangaroo Island will be interrupted at two different times tomorrow, Thursday 8 July.

Customers in Kingscote, American River, McGillivray, Parndana, and those to the west of Parndana, will be without power for around 15 minutes at 5am, and again between 3pm and 4pm that afternoon.

The power interruptions are due to customers being switched onto and off of the back-up generator, in order for ETSA Utilities crews to conduct essential maintenance work on the Penneshaw to American River line.

This work involves replacing a section of line to ensure security of supply for Kangaroo Island customers.
